«Taking Brand Initiative: Aligning Strategy, Culture, and Identity»

Professors Mary Jo Hatch and Majken Schultz began their research into corporate branding on a foundation of expertise in the areas of organizational culture and identity. They will take the position that there is no reason to reinvent the wheel and offer their thoughts about how to leverage existing cultural knowledge about an organization to inform strategic change that resonates with corporate brand management. They will explore how managers and executives can most effectively interact with and influence their organization's cultures, how subcultures can undermine the cross-functional collaboration a corporate brand requires, and whether or not you want to engage stakeholders in your cultural change efforts. They will present their model of corporate branding, featured in their new book *Taking Brand Initiative: How Companies Can Align Strategy, Culture and Identity Through Corporate Branding*, and work from this foundation to explain how to manage your corporate brand.

Professor Majken Schultz, Copenhagen Business School, Denmark

Majken Schultz is professor of management at Copenhagen Business School and a partner in the Reputation Institute. She is co-editor of *Corporate Branding: Purpose, People, Process* (with Yun Mi Antorini and Fabian Csaba) and author of *On Studying Organizational Cultures: Diagnosis and Understanding*. Her articles on corporate branding, organizational cultures, identity and reputation management appear in Harvard Business Review, California Management Review, Corporate Reputation Review, European Journal of Marketing, Human Relations, Academy of Management Review, Academy of Management Journal, Journal of Management Inquiry and Organization Studies. Mary Jo Hatch, professor emerita of the University of Virginia, is an adjunct and visiting professor at the Copenhagen Business School. She is author of *Organization Theory: Modern, Symbolic and Postmodern Perspectives*, now in its second edition (with Ann Cunliffe), and *The three Faces of Leadership: Manager, Artist and Priest* (with Monika Kostera and Andrzej Kozminski). Her research on corporate branding, organizational culture, and organizational identity has been published in Harvard Business Review, California Management Review, European Journal of Marketing, Journal of Brand Management, Human Relations, Academy of Management Review, Administrative Science Quarterly, and Organization Studies. The RER Sécheron railway station (Coppet/Genève).

From bus 1: Get off at Jardin Botanique. Cross Rue de Lausanne.

From RER: Walk down Av. de la Paix towards Jardin botanique. Turn right in Chemin de Mines.

From trams 13 and 15. Get off at Avenue de France. Cross and turn left on Av. Blanc.

By car

From the A1 motorway, take the Route 1/Route de Lausanne exit. From downtown Geneva, head towards Barton Parc. Limited parking available on-site at Merck Serono.

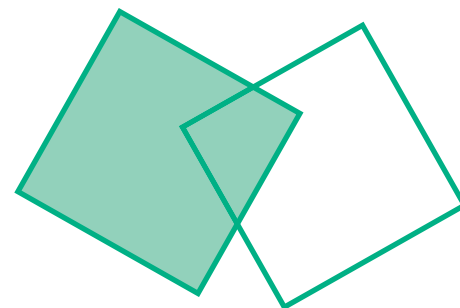
